Texas Property Tax Code, Section 22.28 and 22.29, if a person/business owner fails to file or timely file, a Business Personal Property Rendition, the Chief Appraiser must impose a penalty in an amount equal to 10% of the total amount of taxes imposed by the taxing units. The Chief Appraiser must also impose a 50% penalty if a person/business owner files a false statement or report with the intent to commit fraud or to evade a tax. On a written request by the property owner, the Chief Appraiser may waive the penalty imposed if the Chief Appraiser determines that the person/business owner exercised reasonable diligence to comply with or has substantially complied with the rendering requirements.
